which is a 100% volunteer driven, non-profit organization dedicated to educating and training everyday citizens to step up in emergency situations.

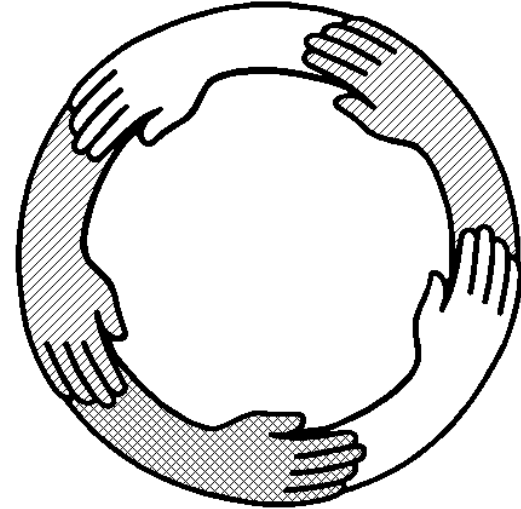
And
